QUALIFICATIONS: Mental Health professional that has a minimum of a Master's Degree in Mental Health Counseling, Social Work or Marriage and Family Therapy from an accredited university. Licensed Addiction Counselor in Training, working toward an LAC. LPC, LPC-MH, LCSW, LCSW-PIP licensure preferred. In addition, must demonstrate experience, skill and competence in working with individuals with Severe and Persistent Mental Illness (SPMI).

JOB SUMMARY: A clinical mental health position responsible for providing individual and group psychotherapy to individuals with Severe Mental Illness (SMI). In addition, the individual will participate in the team and individual consultation, as well as, assist in the coordination of services with other CARE Staff. The Mental Health Therapist will also complete mental health assessments from various referral sources in the community. Position requires a working knowledge of the therapeutic process including establishing therapeutic rapport, knowledge of diagnostic criteria for psychological disorders, case conceptualization skills, and implementation of evidence-based practices.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS: Essential job functions include but are not limited to:

1. Provide quality therapeutic counseling services in the CARE Program to assigned clients.
2. Provide individual, group and family therapy.
3. Maintain quality clinical records and documentation as required by agency and payer source and as outlined in policy and procedures manual.
4. Participate in quality assurance process in keeping accurate clinical records.
5. Maintain licensure required to complete your job classification.
6. Provide on-call and crisis counseling coverage as assigned.
7. Achieve productivity level as assigned.
