

Go Immutable Privacy Policy

Go Immutable (henceforward "**Go Immutable**", "**we**" or "**us**") understands that Users care about their privacy and how their personally identifiable information is used and shared.

As such, we at Go Immutable have a firm commitment to the privacy and protection of our Users.

This Privacy Policy applies to the information we collect via our Service and our Site and describes how we collect and use such information. It also describes the choices available to you regarding our use of your personally identifiable information and how you can access and update this information. By visiting our Site or using our Service, you are consenting to the practices described in this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy does not apply to any third-party websites, services or applications, even if they are accessible through our Service or our Site.

Capitalized terms that are not defined in this Privacy Policy have been defined in our Terms of Service. Therefore, please make sure you have read and understand our Terms of Service.

Your personally identifiable information may be transferred to, and maintained on computers or servers, that are located outside of your state, province or other governmental jurisdiction where the privacy laws may not be as protective as those in your jurisdiction. If you are located outside the US and choose to provide your personally identifiable information to us, we may transfer your personally identifiable information to the United States and process it there. We work with our customers and vendors with regard to legal compliance pertaining to data transfers.

Our guiding principles

1. We only collect necessary information about you
2. We do not share personally identifiable information except for obvious reasons (such as when necessary to provide our Service or if required by law)
3. We will not spam you

What information do we collect about you?

User-provided information - Go Immutable only collects personally identifiable information that you have voluntarily provided to us. We only ask for information that's necessary

for you (and your Authorized Users) to access, use and pay for our Service, including, but not limited to, the creation of your Account. This information may include, but is not limited to, names, email addresses, mailing addresses and credit card numbers. If you correspond with us by email, we may retain the content of your email messages and our responses so that we can provide you with better customer service. We also store

information that you have indirectly provided to us via Your Content and Application(s), which may include, without limitation, your Users' personally identifiable information.

Log file information - Information is automatically reported by your browser each time you access a web page. When you use the Service, our servers automatically record certain information that your web browser sends. These server logs may include information such as your web request, Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser type, referring / exit pages and URLs, number of clicks, domain names, landing pages, pages viewed, and other such information. We use this information to identify potential security issues, to analyze (and may engage third parties to analyze) trends, to administer the Site, to track averaged User movements around the Site and to gather demographic information about our User base as a whole. We may also use this information to improve, customize and enhance our Service by expanding the Service's features and functionality and tailoring the Service to our Users' preferences. We do not use this information to identify individual Users.

What do we use your information for?

We use your personally identifiable information only to provide you with the expected features and functionality of the Service and to respond to customer service requests. By providing Go Immutable your email address you consent to our using the email address to send you critical Service notices, including any notices required by law, in lieu of communication by postal mail.

We may also use your email address to send you other messages, including Go Immutable news, updates, related product or service information. Out of respect for your privacy, you may choose to stop receiving these messages by following unsubscribe instructions included in these emails or you can email us at info@goimmutable.com. We do need to send you certain communications regarding the Service and you will not be able to opt out of those communications - e.g., communications regarding critical Service notifications, updates to our Terms of Service or this Privacy Policy or information about billing.

When would we share your information?

Go Immutable does not sell, trade, rent or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating or analyzing our Site or Service, conducting our business, or servicing you (e.g. to process your credit card transactions or provide customer support services). These companies are authorized to use your personally identifiable information only as necessary to provide these services to us.

We may store personally identifiable information in locations outside the direct control of Go Immutable (e.g. on servers at hosting providers).

We may also disclose your personally identifiable information:

- as required by law, such as to comply with a subpoena, or similar legal process
- when we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others or the public in general, investigate fraud, or respond to a government request, or to stop any activity that we consider illegal or legally actionable
- if Go Immutable Inc. is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of its assets
- to any other third party but only with your prior consent to do so
- If you invite another User to share your Application (e.g. by adding an additional account user), we will share the Application and associated Content with that User

How can you access your information?

If your personally identifiable information changes, or if you no longer desire our Service, you may correct, update, amend or remove it by making the change on our member information page or by contacting us by email, telephone or postal mail at the contact information listed below. We will make reasonable efforts to respond to your request within 30 days.

We will retain your information for as long as your Account is active or as needed to provide you with the Service. We will retain and use your information as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, back-up purposes, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.

What tracking technologies do we utilize?

We use cookies on our Site. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer for record-keeping purposes.

We use both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are required for most of the functionality of our Site and for web tools such as our administrative application. These cookies are used to implement application authentication, allowing us to implement secure access to your data. A session ID cookie expires when you close your browser.

A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive for an extended period of time. You can remove persistent cookies by following directions provided in your Internet browser's "help" file. Persistent cookies enable us to track and target your interests and to improve our Site.

If you reject cookies, you may still use our Site, but your ability to use some key areas of our Site, such as our administrative application tools, will be disabled.

Our Site does not have the capability to respond to "Do Not Track" signals received from various web browsers.

In addition, our Site utilizes Google Analytics to gather information about how our Users engage with the Site and Google Invisible reCAPTCHA to validate Users on the Site. Google Analytics and the Google Invisible reCAPTCHA are services provided by Google and are subject to the Google [Privacy Policy](#) and the Google [Terms of Service](#). How do we protect your information?

The security of your personal information is important to us. On those pages where our users can register for our service and/or log-in, we encrypt the transmission of that information using secure socket layer technology (SSL).

We follow generally accepted standards to protect the personally identifiable information submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it. No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure, however. Therefore, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.
