## LEAD Abatement Course Descriptions

### **Lead Worker**

Based on the EPA model curriculum, this 16 hour course is designed to meet the requirements for persons who perform lead abatement in residential/child-occupied building (40 CFR Part 745) Upon completion of the course students are given an examination covering all core-course concepts. This exam qualifies participants to apply for accreditation from the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality. This is a 2-day course

### **Lead Project Supervisor**

This Lead Abatement Supervisor training provides information on lead-based paint abatement and regulatory guidelines for those individuals that will plan and/or oversee lead abatement work. A certified Supervisor can perform all the duties that a Lead Worker can, and additionally a Supervisor is responsible for occupant safety during the abatement process and for writing the abatement plan. The course focuses on essential abatement procedures including site preparation, contract planning, project management, abatement implementation and record-keeping. This workshop prepares you to apply your knowledge to the field, with extensive hands-on training and real-world examples from experienced instructors. This is a 4-day course

### **Lead Inspector**

This Lead Inspector Initial training provides information for individuals who perform lead-based paint inspections and/or clearance examinations on abatement and renovation projects. This course will teach the legal and technical issues and obligations facing inspectors when inspecting for lead hazards. Students will also learn how to determine whether the lead-based paint or other lead hazards are present in quantities that would, according to regulatory guidelines, require abatement. This is a 3-day course.

## **Lead Risk Assessor**

This Lead Risk Assessor training course is for those individuals who wish to perform lead-based paint Risk Assessment or Lead Hazard Screening services. This class meets EPA's training requirements and will prepare students to perform on-site inspection, take samples, determine the severity of lead hazards, and develop options for eliminating those hazards. EPA and state regulations require that an individual wishing to be certified as a Risk Assessor must first successfully complete the Lead Inspector class and meet the necessary education and experience requirements. A Risk Assessor can perform all the duties that an Inspector can. In addition, a Risk Assessor is responsible for identifying all lead-based paint hazards and making recommendations for their treatment, including maintenance and monitoring schedules.

Pre-requisites - Completion of Lead Inspector or proof of accreditation of Lead Inspector

This is a 2-day course.
