Comparing International Student Numbers

- Gains/losses of 1-50 students can be part of normal flow of student enrolment.
- Gains of 100 or more students have a concentrated effort to increase student enrolment.
- Decreases of 50 - 230 students have a lack of effort to support international students.
- For every 15 international students, the college gains about \$ 75,000 in extra tuition and about \$ 444,000 in revenue to local community taxes.
- Colleges with significant decreases lose funds at a time when resources are scarce

Percentage of International Students Compared to Total Student Population (2018)

- 44 colleges have less than 1% of their students being international
- 15 colleges have 1% - 1.9% of their students being international
- 8 colleges have more than 7% of their students being international
- Many smaller colleges have larger percentages of international students than larger colleges. This shows that a large presence of international students is not dependent on college location nor size.
