Dorchester County Partners Working Together to Protect Citizens

Cambridge, MD (March 17, 2020) – In response to the Coronavirus Disease 2019, or COVID-19, Dorchester County officials are working together to protect the citizens of Dorchester County. A team made up of Dorchester County Health Department, Dorchester County Emergency Services, Dorchester County Government, City of Cambridge, Town of Hurlock, Dorchester County Public Schools, University of Maryland Shore Regional Health, law enforcement agencies, Dorchester Chamber of Commerce, and more are partnering to prepare, monitor, and respond to the evolving situation. Ongoing updates will be provided to inform the community.

Dorchester County currently has no confirmed COVID-19 positive cases. Dorchester County’s Emergency Operations Center is running at an enhanced level of activation. Residents are encouraged to take every precaution possible to protect themselves and others. Citizens are reminded to stay home, practice social distancing, and wash your hands frequently.
