Class Notes

All tests may be in Standard (20 x 60) Arena.

CLASS 1 and 2 – Same horse and rider combination cannot show in Training Level or above.

CLASS 3 – Same horse and rider combination cannot show above Training Level Test 1.

CLASS 8 – Does not count for show high point awards. Does count for year-end awards.

CLASS 16 – Not allowed to compete in any tests. Not allowed to ride in the show ring.

AWARDS: Each class will be awarded ribbons 1st-6th place. Ribbon for Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded for JR, AA, and Open. Show management reserves the right to combine, divide, cap, or cancel classes as entries warrant.

ENTRIES: Must use Vienna Farm entry form available on VF's website, and SMDA/TMDS websites. Complete entries are processed according to postmark date. Pre-entries are not accepted. Make checks payable to Vienna Farm. Once the show is full, entries are placed on a wait list. **Entries must include:** Negative Coggins within 36 months for in-state horses; within 12 months for out-of-state horses. Full payment including class fees and other fees. Riders sharing a coach, groom or trailer-ride will be scheduled together instead of by class. List all riders in your group on the entry form. **Class Fees:** \$25/class. \$15/schooling on grounds. **Other Fees:** \$5 office fee. \$35 for nonnegotiable check. *No refunds after closing date, including Acts of God.

GOVERNANCE: USDF rules and regulations are followed for warm up and show ring, including equipment checks for both horse and rider. ASTM Helmets and closed toe riding boots required. Jackets required unless waived by Judge. Helmets must be buckled at all times while mounted. No lunging in the Indoor Arena.

TIMES: Preliminary times are posted the Thursday prior to the show date on viennafarm.com and the Vienna Farm Facebook page, or email secretary. Official show times on day sheet provided at check-in on show day and will be followed.

DIRECTIONS: From the North, at the Standish intersection of Rt. 114 and Rt. 35, follow Rt. 114 South for 2.5 miles. Before the farm, turn right onto Spiller Rd., in 200 yards turn left into Hay Barn parking lot. From the South, at the Gorham intersection of Rt. 114 and Rt. 25, follow Rt.114 North for 4.5 miles. After passing the farm, turn left onto Spiller Rd, in 200 yards, turn left into Hay Barn parking lot.

FOOTING: 20x60 show arena with dust free sand/geo fiber/rubber mix. Warm up available in indoor arena with sand/rubber mix, or grass field.

FOOD: No food available on show grounds.

OTHER: Porta potty located at the parking lot by the Hay Barn. Bring your own water. Carry-In/Carry-Out (trash, manure etc.). Please pick-up after yourself and your horse in the parking lot. Entry Packet with bridle number will be at unmanned check-in table. NO SMOKING in or near any building.

COVID-19 POLICIES:

- This show will be managed under "Show & Go" guidelines to reduce the number of people here at any one time, and limit face-to-face contact.
- Rides may not be grouped by class. Scores and placings will be processed after the show and published to the farm Facebook page.
- Bring a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope (SASE) for Test Results and Awards. Envelope must be at least 4x6, Postage \$3.00. Leave at check-in table.
- Arrive no more than 60 minutes prior to your ride time; Enter warm up no more than 30 minutes prior to your ride time; Leave the show grounds no more than 30 minutes after your ride time. Your results and ribbon will be mailed to you if you provide a SASE.
- Competitor plus one person only (coach, groom/assistant). No spectators.
- Masks are required at all times except while in the show ring. Masks must be worn while riding in indoor. Please bring your own supply of hand sanitizer and maintain responsibility for physical distancing.
- No facility/restroom access. No entry into main barn except for boarders and staff.

Failure to comply with these policies will result in removal from the show grounds with no refund.
