ADD HOUSEHOLD MEMBER

To add a household member, please go to the Yavapai-Apache Nation's website and download the household change form. Please complete the form and be sure to add the household member's information to the form including their employer. Please email the form to carol.baca@yan-tribe.org or take a picture of the form and send to 928-202-6837. We will update the information with the security personnel at the checkpoints as long as we receive the form Monday through Friday by 2:00pm.

EMERGENCY WORK ORDERS ONLY

Please call the emergency on call number **ONLY for the following emergencies**, water/sewer leaks, a/c, plumbing, and electrical issues. **DO NOT CALL** on-call for any other questions as this takes them away from their work when they are addressing emergency work orders.
