

Field Technician Job Description

We keep people safe. Our technicians apply science-based protocols to combat and destroy pathogens in assisted living, food processing facilities, offices, schools, and stores. We use a triple sanitizing protocol starting with Biomist alcohol sprayed on high touch surfaces, fogging with a neutral solution approved by the EPA for food preparation surfaces, and reinforced with medical-grade UVC lighting. Equally important, we provide communications tools so our clients can communicate to their customers why they can confidently use facility.

We believe people are the foundation of a strong business and effectively serving our clients. Our goal is to attract and retain great people, invest in their development, and build a strong sense of team.

Requirements

- Execute and continually improve our sanitizing protocols. Team members follow our standard operating procedures at client sites.
- Judgement and discipline to use and maintain potentially hazardous chemicals and equipment, seek guidance from sanitary scientists where appropriate, and always maintain safe practices.
- Ability to master concepts and terms related to sanitary science and industrial hygiene. For example, technicians should understand the difference between how different sanitizing solutions work and affect surfaces.
- Ensure compliance with EPA, OSHA and MIOSHA requirements as well as CDC guidance. For example, we train to use and maintain personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Engage clients effectively to understand their needs and inform them why and how our services function. Where appropriate, identify cross sell and up sell opportunities. Most importantly, guide clients to make their facilities safe.
- Basic fluency with mobile apps. Field team use a mobile application to track implementing protocols at client locations. Team members should also have basic familiarity with Microsoft Outlook, Word, and Excel.
- Effective verbal communication.
