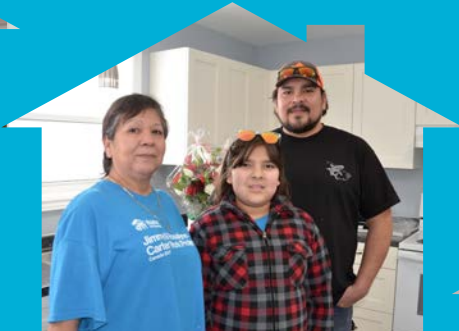


Our Story

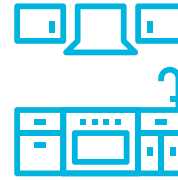

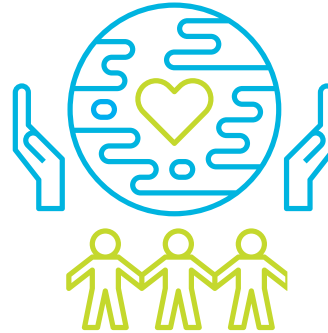

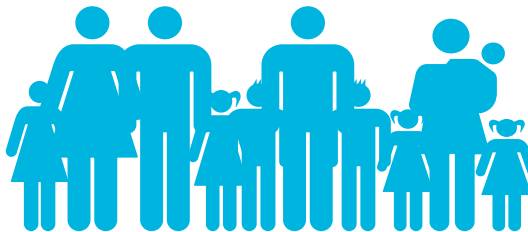
