### **Job Description and Tasks**

The Security Support Technician (SST) will support technology and equipment demonstrations for DoD and Government customers. Equipment will include advanced security and counter drone systems such as radars, EO/IR sensors, passive detection systems, and kinetic/non-kinetic weapons. The SST will participate field exercises and maneuvers, as well as support independent tests and evaluations. The SST plans and coordinates training and evaluation events and presents demonstrations. *This is a PART TIME position with hours and duties changing from month to month.*

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Responsible for setup, demonstration and coordination of products and systems for air, ground, vehicular, and manpack applications for US government testing.
- Provides analysis, troubleshooting, rework, repair, calibration, inspection, and maintenance duties on a broad application of complex electronic instruments, assemblies, subassemblies, standards and systems.
- Assist with development of training support packages to include Programs of Instruction, training modules, manuals and graphic training aids.
- Interface with potential customers and existing customers to educate on select technologies
- Interface with customer base for technology review and requirement development / technology refinement IAW customer operational needs.
- Plan and coordinate customer training events throughout the continental U.S. in multiple sites, primarily DHS or DOD bases.
- Responsible for diagnosing, troubleshooting, reworking & repairing complex instruments, assemblies, subassemblies and systems.
