Madame Gandhi to Perform at Benefit for Women's Homelessness in Los Angeles

LOS ANGELES – The artist and activist Madame Gandhi will be playing at a benefit for women's homelessness in Los Angeles on Thursday, June 14, 2018. Toast to DWC, presented by Wells Fargo, will be held at Angel City Brewery and is hosted by the Downtown Women's Center Leadership Council.

The event will feature food and drink samples from local restaurants Barcito, Café Dulce, Kon-Tiki Taco, Party & Sushi, and Urban Radish along with a pop-up trunk show from the MADE by DWC Resale Boutique. In addition to Madame Gandhi's performance, Toast to DWC will feature performances from Cherose, Morgan St. Jean, and DJ Ichi.

She studied mathematics at Georgetown University and worked as the first ever data analyst at Interscope Records before going on to receive her MBA from Harvard.
