Terms of Service and Conditions for Using Lake Phoenix

SCUBA Instructors: All SCUBA instructors who teach at Lake Phoenix must meet active status requirements with their respective agency (current membership and liability insurance). The instructor – student ratio for in-water activities must be met according to the prevailing course standards of their respective agency. All SCUBA instructors will receive complimentary admission when leading a group of three (3) or more paying divers. Teaching status or not, Instructor / Divemaster waiver must be accomplished.

Divemasters: All Divemasters who supervise diving activities at Lake Phoenix must meet active status requirements with their respective agencies in terms of current membership and liability insurance. Supervision of diving activities may be direct or indirect. A divemaster will receive complimentary admission to Lake Phoenix when listed on a group manifest when there are five (5), 2 DM's per nine to twelve and 3 DM's thirteen and up paying divers in the group. Teaching status or not, Instructor / Divemaster waiver must be accomplished.

SCUBA Divers: Daily pricing posted on the internet and subject to change. This includes parking and admission. All certified divers must present their certification card to the staff at the office to obtain admission for SCUBA diving. Non-certified divers must be supervised by an instructor when scuba diving at Lake Phoenix. Non-certified waivers DO NOT cover them for a buddy dive after certification. Please have them do the certified diver waiver prior to buddy diving activities.

SOLO Divers: Solo drivers must declare their intent upon registration, present their solo certification and be so equipped in the water. Failure to do so will result in termination of diving and park privileges. Solo divers will do a solo waiver as well as their other waiver.

Law Enforcement, Military, Public Safety trainers will be held to the standards of the training for the law enforcement, military or public safety agency. The group leader is responsible for obtaining the lake pass (entrance for all personnel to include appropriate assumption of risk (liability release) and parking permit(s) for each vehicle as required.

Groups of 10 or More: The group leader is responsible for collecting all fees and the appropriate assumption of risk (liability release) from each member of the group, regardless of age or circumstance.

Seasonal & Daily Operation: Lake Phoenix will be operational daily during Summer Season to include weekends and holidays during regular season (April – October).

Summer Season operation will be daily. Please check website hours.

Winter Season is November - March. Visits during the off-season to dive and camp are always available by appointment; see our reservation page on the internet. Hours for winter season operation will be 09:00 – 17:00

Alcoholic Beverages & Smoking: as this is a family place, Smoking, Vaping, Chewing Tobacco products, Alcoholic Beverages, and Controlled Substances as well as glass containers, are strictly prohibited from the premises at all times. Violators will be told to leave the premises.

Firearms/Fireworks/Explosives to include firecrackers, sparklers, etc. are strictly prohibited to be displayed or used on the premises at all times. Violators will be prosecuted.

Trash and Garbage: Please help keep Lake Phoenix a clean and great place to dive. Place your trash in the provided receptacles and diligently inform divers and visitors in your group or class about our respect and care for the environment. Thank you!

Lodging: Electric sites go fast so make reservations early. No reservation needed for tent camping. Please check our website for other lodging facilities and ask for the divers special.

To ensure your and everyone's safety we ask all divers, swimmers and visitors to abide by the operational rules and standards of Lake Phoenix at all times. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated.
