PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SERVICE TO ANYONE FOR ANY REASON.

CAMPERS: When the office is open, register upon arrival. When office is closed please use the late arrival process found on our website. RV rates are based on four adults. Fees are always due in advance. RV sites and Tent with elect require reservation to ensure availability.

CAMPFIRES: All campfires will be confined to existing fire rings. You will not leave fires unattended at any time. A 5-gallon bucket with water must be ready for use. Fire buckets are available inside the office.

CHECK OUT TIME: Check out time for RV or tent camping, day diving or swimming is 5:00 PM. Check out time for cabin camping is 2:00 PM. If you need more time check with office staff.

QUIET HOURS: From 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM.

SPEED LIMIT: Is 10 mph on driveway and 5 mph in camping and parking areas.

BATHHOUSE: Please help to keep our bathhouse clean at all times. Divers, please rinse your booties prior to entering.

ALCOHOL/DRUGS/SMOKING: Lake Phoenix is a No Smoking, Vaping or chewing tobacco Facility. Alcohol and drugs are not permitted on the premises. Please **NO GLASS** containers.

FIREWORKS / FIREARMS: Fireworks are not permitted to be set off in park at any time. Firearms are not permitted at Lake Phoenix.

RV SITE: Keep your RV site clean and tidy at all times. No garbage cans or bags allowed outside your RV. Sack and tie all garbage and place inside dumpster near the Tractor shed and Shop area.

CHILDREN: Parents are responsible for their child's behavior at all times. Do not leave children unsupervised in park at any time. Make sure your child understands the basic park rules. For their safety and the safety of others NO children under the age of 4 at or near the lake.

PETS: Please advise office when registering or when making a reservation if you plan to bring a pet. No pets allowed in the Staging area, Pavilions, at or in the lake. Pets are restricted to the camping or parking area. No pet is to disturb others with barking. **IMPORTANT:** Pick up after your pet immediately. Pets are permitted only when registered at office and when these rules are followed. Dogs trained to attack, bite or guard are not allowed inside the park.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: Campers, divers and swimmers will assume all responsibility for their own actions, the actions of their children and the behavior of their pets, to include personal injury, property damage or wrongful death.

SWIMMERS: No rock climbing or throwing, and children under 12 are encouraged to wear a life jacket or PFD.

PAVILIONS: These are available by reservation through our website for a fee.
