The Soil2Service Commitment Scholarship is open to all incoming students that enroll full-time in DIG courses for one year (four quarters). The scholarship is renewable for a second year (four quarters) provided the student is enrolled full-time, is academically in good standing (see student catalog) and is up-to-date with tuition payments.

First Year Eligibility Requirements:

The student is enrolled in the Detroit Institute of Gastronomy full-time with a completed and signed enrollment agreement on file.

Second Year Renewal Eligibility Requirements:

The student is enrolled in the Detroit Institute of Gastronomy and is full-time.

The student is academically in good standing

The student is up-to-date with tuition payments.

Student will be notified by email of any scholarship award or denial.
