

Family Retreats Waiver & Terms for Enrollment

1. Registration will not be accepted unless accompanied by a non-refundable deposit of \$250.00.
2. All payments, less the \$250.00 non-refundable deposit, will be refunded should the registration be cancelled prior to July 19. Anyone withdrawing after July 19, for any reason other than illness or injury will be charged the full fee.
3. There are no refunds or prorations for early departures unless it is due to illness or injury.
4. Camp Alleghany reserves the right to dismiss, without refund, any participant whose behavior is inappropriate in a camp community.
5. Camp Alleghany reserves the right to use photographs of our Family Retreats participants for promotional purposes.
6. During Family Retreats there is no medical staff available on site at Camp Alleghany. The Greenbrier Valley Medical Center is approximately 15 minutes away.
7. The entrance to camp is across a river, via cable ferry or row boat. Parents shall be responsible for the control and safety of their minor children on the barge and rowboat. A lifeguard is not provided; you may choose to wear a life jacket if you wish.
8. Camp operates with the highest safety standards. However it does not assume liability for sickness, disease, or accidents.
9. Each registrant acknowledges that he or she has been advised that there will be people from different parts of the country, including areas where there have been significant numbers of COVID-19 cases, and each registrant specifically assumes the risk for himself, herself, and their minor children, of exposure to COVID-19 from people attending Family Retreats at Camp Alleghany.
10. Each registrant knowingly, freely, and voluntarily chooses to participate in Family Retreats with the knowledge of the risks which they are assuming for themselves and their minor children.
11. Each registrant further agrees to follow all guidelines for social distancing, masks and such other precautions that may be required by Camp Alleghany, the CDC, the Greenbrier County Health Department, or any other regulatory body.
12. Each registrant acknowledges by signing this agreement that he or she has a duty to other participants to follow the appropriate guidelines and agrees to assume responsibility for their own health and safety of their families while participating in Family Camp.
13. Each registrant agrees to depart camp immediately if she or she, or any member of their family, experiences any COVID-19 related symptoms.
14. Each registrant agrees to report any COVID-19 indicating symptoms, for any family member attending Camp Alleghany, should they present within 14 days following departure.
15. Each registrant for himself, herself, and their minor children specifically releases Camp Alleghany, its agents and employees, from any and all liability for injury or damage which they might sustain while participating, or damage to property which they might sustain while participating in Family Retreats, including exposure to COVID-19.
