The Society collects and makes accessible materials related to the history of the Town and its various neighborhoods, items associated with domestic life and livelihood of its residents (especially fishing and tourism), information and objects related to natural history, the ocean, marine vessels and aids to navigation, the City of Portland, and neighboring islands. Photographs, documents, and printed matter of significance to the Town and its inhabitants are also included.

We also organize field trips of interest to members, including tours of other islands, points of interest in the Portland area, and museums in the area. Our exhibit space is located in the Long Island Community Center.

Regular meetings are held the third Saturday in January, March, May, June, July, August, September, and November at the Community Center We'd like to have you to join us!
