

## **ABOUT THE AMERICAN INDIAN HEALTH COMMISSION**

The American Indian Health Commission for Washington State (Commission) is a tribal consortium formed in 1994 by leaders from the Washington State Tribes and Urban Indian Health Programs (UIHPs). The Commission is governed by representatives from the twenty-nine Tribes and two UIHPs. For over 20 years, the Commission has advanced tribal-state collaboration to improve the health status of American Indians/Alaska Natives (AI/AN). By providing a forum for identifying priorities and developing a unified voice, the work of the Commission focuses on advocacy, policy, and program development.
