



## Simplified Relaunch Plan

***Note: This is only a condensed version of the Relaunch Plan.***

Rocky Curling Club is hopeful that all facility users will respect both this document and its intent. Those not in compliance will be made aware of interim rules and regulations, If they choose to not be in compliance they will be asked to leave the facility and may have member privileges revoked.

**ALL FACILITY USERS:including spares!**

**Will be required to sign an appropriate waiver, to complete their registration.**

Given the extremely serious repercussions associated with COVID-19 FACILITY USERS will not be permitted FACILITY USAGE unless these waivers are signed. The waivers will be available through the on-line registration as well as manual (paper) registration.

### Reducing Congestion and Facilitating Foot Traffic.

#### **Building Access / Egress.**

- The Main North East entrance will be the primary entrance/exit to the curling facility.
- The South parking lot door will be locked and only used as an emergency exit only.
- Lounge access will be through the Main sliding doors only and the stairwell access will be locked from entry but will be available for building exit (egress).
- Curling Lobby restricted to active curlers/Coaches & Staff only.
- Anyone accessing the building should use hand sanitizers
- Everyone must read and comply to self screening protocols (posters)
- Masks are not mandatory but are encouraged in congested areas or for individuals that feel at risk.

#### **Staging for play & End of Games:**

- Masks are not mandatory but encouraged while in the lobby/dressing room areas.
- Curlers are asked to only show up in the lobby/dressing room 5-10 minutes before their scheduled ice-time fully dressed other than footwear and ready to play.
- Curlers are asked to leave the lobby promptly after the end of their game.
- Curlers will stage according to the ice they are on. For example sheet E will enter the ice first, then Ice D, Ice C, Ice B and last Ice A.
- Players will exit the closest exit after their game respecting others still playing.
- Locker rooms will be restricted/limited to a certain amount of curlers.
- Do not leave (other than outside shoes on designated areas) personal belongings in the lobby.

## Simplified Relaunch Plan

### Strict Adherence to Duration of Game Play:

- Curling is a 2 hour game. No end shall start 1hr.45min after the game start time.
- The “commencement” of an end is once the first delivered rock crosses the t-line.
- Skips should note start time and follow the 1hr.45min rule.

### Restricting Use of Rental - Club Equipment:

In order to properly manage club equipment all members are asked to bring their own equipment and If club equipment is used it is the responsibility of the user to sanitize the equipment used. Rocky Curling Club will not be responsible to sanitize equipment.

### Physical Distancing - Rules of Play

**Alternate game start/finish** Sheets 1,3,5 home end, Sheets 2,4 away end.

- **No Hand shaking allowed.** (tap brooms, wave)
- **Deciding Hammer! Coin flip**
  - Vice skip or any player with a coin can flip their own coin.
- **Keeping Score!** Vice Skip on team starting (hammer) keeps score for both teams.
- **Measuring rocks!** Vice Skip not keeping score will be responsible to measure as required.
- Do not touch rocks other than your own (2) with your hands.
- Do not ready opponents’ rocks (throwing end)
- **Non-throwing team!**
  - Skip/Vice Skip remains behind hack until the throwing team gives up the house.
  - Players remain on same side of Ice (left hand from home end)
  - Sweepers remain at center ice 6 ft apart until the throwing team is done.
  - Player waiting to throw waits at the hog line until the opposing team is done.
  - No Sweeping of any stones behind the tee-line.
- **Throwing Team!**
  - Skip/Vice Skip have control of the house.
  - Skip/Vice Skip not allowed to sweep at any time.
  - One Sweeper only per delivered rock.
  - Alternate sweeper should remain at hog on opposite non-throwing team (right)
