Canine Influenza

There have been confirmed cases of Canine Influenza in Monmouth County, New Jersey this month.

All social dogs - like those who travel, visit boarding or grooming facilities, or exercise and socialize with other dogs - are at risk for contracting the highly contagious dog flu. This virus can spread from one dog to another via direct physical contact, virus particles in the air (coughs/sneezes), and even through objects touched by infected dogs.

Because new cases have been confirmed in Central NJ, Oldwick Animal Hospital must now strongly recommend that our canine patients be vaccinated against Canine Influenza.
