

Freshman YEAR ONLY -- Students may complete up to 15 hours for different family members or neighbors who are in need and cannot afford to pay for help or assistance. These service hours must be turned in before the end of freshman year in order to be counted.

Over the four years of high school, each student is required to complete a *minimum* of 60 service hours. Service hours may be accumulated through volunteering for nonprofit organizations such as Lumen Christi Catholic School, Parish or elementary schools, the Church/parish, nursing homes and local food pantry/kitchens, as well as other approved placements. Hours worked at professional offices, institutions and private clubs will *not* qualify as service hours.

No more than 25 hours may be accumulated at one particular institution.

To be accepted, each service hour slip *must* have the name of the supervisor *clearly* printed and signature with contact number. Without correct or legible information, the service slip is *not* acceptable. Please return completed service form to school chaplain or Religion teacher.

Service Hour Requirements at the end of each year to accumulate 60 Hours to Graduate:

Freshman = 15 Sophomore = 30 Junior = 45 Senior = 60 (60 hours accumulated)
