A short ride takes you back more than a hundred years to nostalgic times of cowboys and mountain men. An era full of history, art, spirit and passion manifested by the love and appreciation of the land is commemorated at 4 Eagle Ranch.

Homesteaded in the late 1800's, 4 Eagle Ranch served as the center of large cattle and sheep operation. In 1991, it was transformed to accommodate groups and individual guests, providing a taste of genuine Colorado. Our 1,100-acre ranch is surrounded by hillsides filled with sagebrush and mountain flowers, mesa trails where the Ute Indians once spread their camps, open pastures along Alkali creek, beaver ponds and majestic views. Guests will enjoy the finest cooking this side of the Continental Divide, along with numerous activity options from live music to zip lines tours, dance instruction to horseback rides, wagon/sleigh rides to paintball, ATV tours to wine tasting, and making s'mores by the campfire under a star-studded Colorado sky.

The Carriage House (circa 1925) is where the Welsh family stored their carriages in the winter months. Remodeled in the fall of 2018. The wonderful characteristics of the Carriage House make it a perfect venue for dinner and dancing.


The Nelson Cabin (circa 1890), a sheep barn relocated from Minturn, was converted into a cozy log cabin setting for dining and friendly chats by the open-hearth fireplace. In the winter months, our Sleigh Ride Dinners are hosted in this venue and the ambiance is unparalleled.

The Event Center, built in 2011 has large, rolling windows provide unparalleled views of our wide-open fields and the Sawatch Mountain Range, while also giving the venue an open-air feel.

The Wedding Pavilion has unobstructed views across the ranch to the Sawatch Mountain Range, which offers a perfect setting for wedding ceremonies and other small gatherings.

The Parlor is ideal for small groups. Situated between the Carriage House and the Nelson Cabin, this venue is perfect for an intimate gathering.

The original Homesteader Cabins (circa 1885) complete the setting, as well as a rodeo arena, horseshoe pits, volleyball, steer head roping, corn hole, campfires and the 4E Trading Post.
