

The Judith Mann Nursing Scholarship

The Judith Mann Nursing Scholarship was created by the North Carolina Associate Degree Nursing Council to honor Judith Mann's commitment to nursing education in North Carolina. Ms. Mann is a registered nurse who served as the Director of Program Services for the North Carolina Community College System. In this capacity, she demonstrated her commitment to associate degree nursing education. To honor Ms. Mann's exemplary service, this nursing scholarship in the amount of \$500 is available to a North Carolina associate degree nursing student who meets the eligibility criteria.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be considered for the Judith Mann Nursing Scholarship, the student must meet the following requirements.

1. Be a resident of North Carolina and be a legal citizen of the United States.
2. Be a full-time nursing student in a North Carolina Associate Degree Nursing program. (*Full-time as defined by community college where student is enrolled.)
3. Have completed 2 semesters in a North Carolina Associate Degree Nursing program.
4. Have earned a grade point average of 3.25 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher in college work.
5. Demonstrate professional promise through skills and attitude.
6. Demonstrate nursing advocacy through campus and/or community involvement.
7. Submit a complete application by the published deadline.
