

The First 100 Years of AMTNJ Archives Project Has Been Completed

Dr. J. Michael Nuspl, AMTNJ President 1979-1980, led a three year project which collected, sorted and preserved artifacts from the vast collection created from the first 100 years of AMTNJ. Nuspl and Dr. Deborah Ives, AMTNJ President 2005-2006, made a presentation of highlights of AMTNJ history at the October 2014 Two-Day Centennial Conference held in New Brunswick, NJ. Nuspl and Ives created a video of their presentation and added outtakes from several conferences held during the 75th year anniversary of AMTNJ with Regina Cullen, AMTNJ President 1978-1979, and Joyce Glatzer, AMTNJ President 1988-1989 serving as narrators.
