## Patient Instructions/Pre-Op Timeline

### Pre-Op Packet

You will receive a "Pre-Op Packet" from your surgeon when your surgery is scheduled. Please review the information and fill out the 1. History and Physical and 2. Medication Form. Any blood work and testing ordered from your surgeon will need to be done as instructed or as soon as possible to avoid any delays with your surgery.

### Pre-Op Assessment

The day before the surgery, a Pre-Op Nurse will call you to review

- Health History – Information should already filled in on the H/P Form.
- Medications – what to take, what not to take and when to take.
- Blood Work – to make sure they are done, where and when.
- Pre-Op Instructions – to review and answer any questions.
- Times – an arrival time and an operative time will be given.

### Day of Surgery

- Don't eat or drink anything. Take medications as instructed.
- Shower/brush teeth, place loose clothing.
- Bring Driver's License and Insurance Cards at scheduled arrival time.
- On arrival, check in with receptionist.
