

100 HW Graduate Fellowship Application 2021-22

The 100 Hispanic Women Graduate Fellowship (**100HWGF**) was created to provide eligible candidates an annual tuition scholarship award up to \$2,500, paid directly to the college or university, throughout the tenure of their Masters or Doctoral Degree Program. All applicants must have achieved high academic standards in prior undergraduate or graduate studies and demonstrate outstanding character, leadership, and commitment to service.

Student Eligibility Criteria:

- Latina student enrolled in an eligible college or university Masters or Doctoral Degree Program (6 credits or more);
- U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident;
- Cumulative undergraduate or graduate GPA of 3.0 or higher;
- Recent completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher throughout graduate/post graduate program;
- Official transcripts submitted two (2) times each year (Fall & Spring Semesters);
- Demonstrated leadership qualities, active participation in public/community service, and commitment to the missions of 100HW and their enrolled college/university; and
- Participate in two (2) annual workshops, annual 100HWGF Award Ceremony, and community service project approved by 100 Hispanic Women National, Inc.

Completed application includes:

- Application Parts 1 & II, Signed Disclosure Agreement, Submission Checklist;
- Current resume;
- Current completed FAFSA;
- Official college or university transcripts for undergraduate, graduate, or postgraduate study (if applicable);
- Current official college or university enrollment letter; and
- Two (2) letters of recommendation that evaluate demonstrated community service, volunteer and leadership activities.
