Tim Harvey, Director of the Jackson YMCA, discussed what they provided to the community through the non-profit organization, and their need for funds that may come from the American Rescue Plan. He stated the YMCA has provided warming sites, food and transportation, as well as other opportunities to those in need in our community. Mr. Harvey felt that personal development and wellness were more important than economic development at this time. As far as the American Rescue Plan, Commissioner Hensler stated they have not seen any money or received any guidance from the State as of yet. Mr. Harvey stressed the YMCA's need for a new wood floor and gave the commissioner's estimates.
