2. **Review and Approve Minutes from last Board Meeting**
Motion: Approve the minutes from State Board Meeting 3/11/17.
Motioned to approve minutes: Jon Harms

Passed unanimously
3. **Region 1 Board Meeting Recap**
 - Dates for Select Camp at Woodward didn't work out this year
 - Probably going to Aspire Gymnastics with Homewood Suites as host
 - Aspire 2nd - 4th of Sept. (Sun-Monday, Memorial Day weekend)
 - So Cal Regional Championship pushed out 1 more year.-Adam Lomax
 - Regional Board Meeting possibly in Hawaii next year.
4. **New JO Programs**
 - This was a verbal review by Tim Klemppauer of what is coming out (Compulsory, Optionals, JD Optionals, TS)
 - Quite a bit of input on the JD Optional Program!
 - Official updates should be out to the gymnastics community by end of July.
5. **Nevada Financials review**
 - 2017 Starting Balance is \$2,802.19
 - Net this year: \$1,174.93
 - Senior gift will be a backpack with logo monogramed.
 - Tim Klemppauer will be attending 2018 Regional Board Meeting possibly in Hawaii next year.
 - Tim Klemppauer requested the JO National checks for 2016 and 2017 on 6/24/17.
 - Tim Klemppauer will attend the State & Regional Chairman Summit this year in September. This is a bi-annual event. The main cost for Nevada is airfare, USAG picks up housing (but not meals).
Discussed: TO PAY the entire airfare this year for coaches attending the Nevada Summer Meeting (\$207.96) instead of just \$200.00. Also to pay for the car rental and gas.

8. Updated Rules & Policies and Constitution

Discussion: Jon Harms working on Rules & Policies and Constitution.

9. Updated State Championships Handbook –

Discussion: Tim and Denise are working on the State Championships Handbook.

10. Nevada State Future Stars events-

Discussion: Will someone in Southern Nevada host Nevada State Future Stars? Northern Nevada looking into 26th and 27th of August or Sept 9th and 10th. Northern Nevada also looking into a possible State Future Stars event (same weekends).

11. Nevada State Championships (2017 review & 2018)

Discussion: Meet and Schedule worked well.

- Maybe flash colors for level 4. This requires a projector.
- Make sure Level 4 information goes out in the Meet Information regarding format and procedures (not flashing scores for Level 4, the ribbon chart, etc).
- Awards in compulsory (Level 4-6) go all the way out in AA.
- Announce awards from the bottom to top (last to first).
- High Sierra had around 250 spectator seating, probably 100 more in Vegas
- Athlete seating in a coral area with chairs
- Gymcats working on dates and times
- Clinic on Sunday and have a column for signing up on clinic on Sunday on Meet Entry Form.
- Other sports on same weekend makes it hard and NCAA and Regionals are same weekend.
- Having a 3 session competition on Saturday with the Level 4's in last session allows Tim to get paperwork done on time.
- Tech Sequence Friday probably 1p.m.
- Meeting continuing at 5pm on Friday night @ Gymcats.
- Possible change to format for 2018:
 - Meet Host might not be able to cancel classes on Saturday. First session after classes on Saturday will be the Level 7, JD & optionals. The second session will be Level 5-6.

- Level 4 session to start at 8 a.m. on Sunday.
- Clinic to start around 11 a.m. (till 2 p.m.) on Sunday.

12. AAI National High School Team Championships (Aspire: May 19-20, 2017)

Discussion: Scott ran it this year. 60 guys.

- AAI wants to promote it as one of their events.
- May open it up to Juniors as well as Seniors

13. State Uniforms

Discussion: Having print out of Regional Teams helped Jon Harms

- Update the design of uniform (Nevada across the back instead of down (the gymnast numbers get in the way).
- Start selling off uniforms: sell “new” 2015 design at \$35; sell “used” 2015 design at \$25
- Sell “new” 2018 design at \$55
- Rent 2018 design at \$20
- Probably getting 24 of 2018 design uniforms
- Remind parents about buying the jackets.
- Maybe getting Nevada State T-shirts for parents.
- Possibly backpacks - Jon Check with Turn.

14. Senior Gifts

Discussed: Watches but most people don't wear them. Tim ordered backpack.

15. Letterman's Jacket for High School Athletes?

Discussion: most kids don't wear them anymore.

16. Xcel for boys

Discussed: Help to grow the sport. Target the gyms that don't have a boys program.

- Wait 1 year to see what happens with Xcel in Nevada and across country.

17. Next year's Summer Meeting

Discussion: Cheaper to host at Tim's; however Jon will look into a house to rent in the Las Vegas area for next year. We will have to see how this fits into the budget.
