If your child was born in 2016 you will need to register them for Kindergarten September 2021. Make sure to follow the SD42 website or FB page for dates. If you require a form from Discovery proving enrollment in our Centre, please email office@discoveryplayhouse.ca

As we return to school, daycare, and preschool, please remember to do the daily health assessment for your child and family before sending them. If there are any signs of sickness as per the CDC Daily Health Check:

- Fever
- Chills
- Cough or worsening of chronic cough
- Breathing difficulties
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting

you must stay home and not attend Discovery Playhouse.

Also, if you have returned from travel outside of Canada in the last 14 days OR confirmed to have had contact with a person COVID-19 positive, you must not attend Discovery Playhouse.
