Champlain  
begins a  
German  
exchange

For the last week and a half Champlain College has been hosting 22 visitors from Germany in the first step of what will eventually become an annual international exchange.

"It's the very beginning. We're just starting to do this for the first time," said Vera Mainka, a German Teacher at the college who lead the effort to coordinate the exchange. "It's going very well."

Mainka explained that the 20 students and two teachers from the town of Gelnhausen are currently in the middle of a massive cultural immersion that has seen them take trips to Montreal and Quebec City as well as New York City in an effort to get real-life experience of this part of North America.

"For a lot of them it's a once in a lifetime experience," the teacher said, explaining that a group from Champlain will be going to Germany in May of 2018 for a similar experience. "In the long run the idea will be for it to be the same
