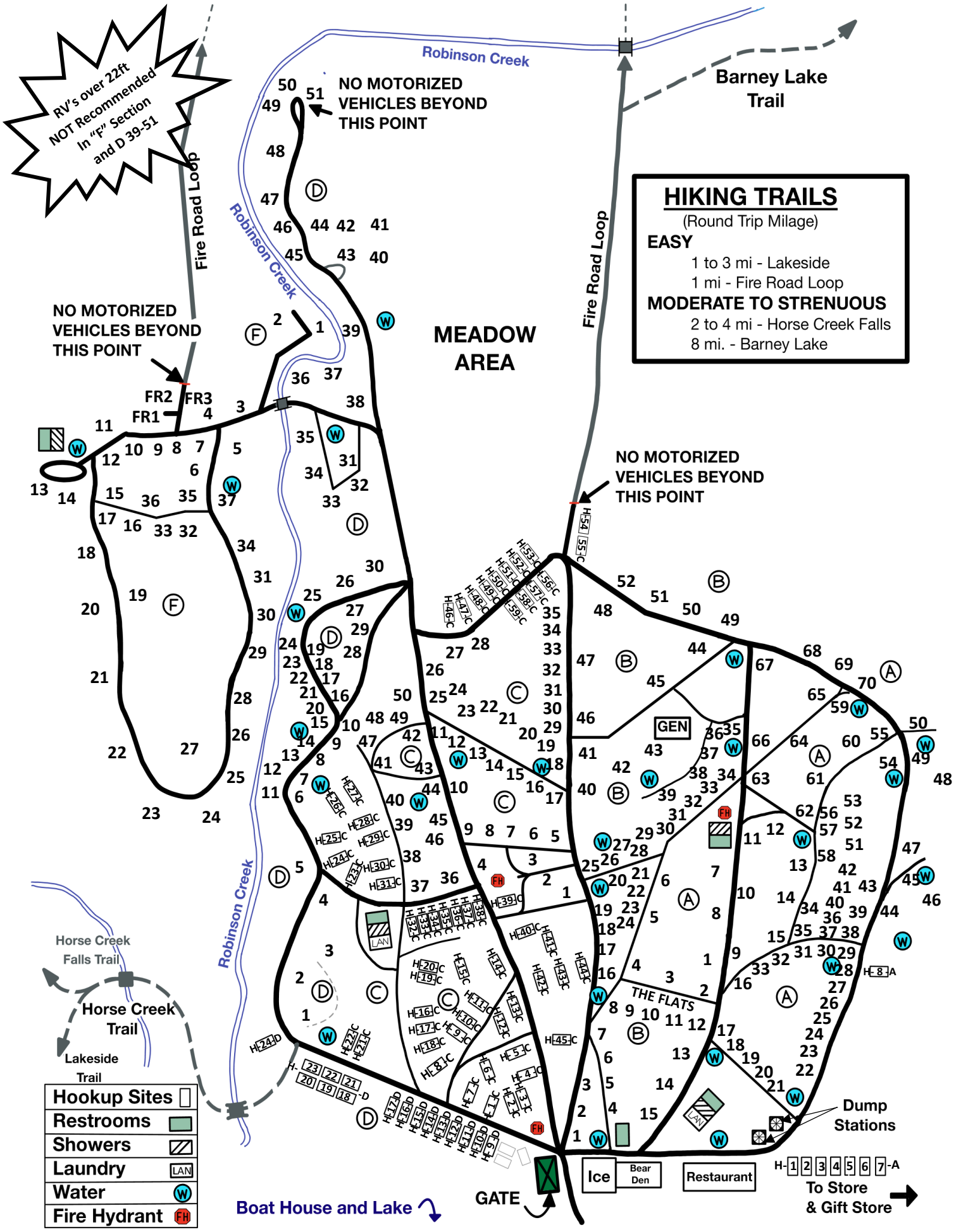


MONO VILLAGE CAMPGROUND



GENERAL RESORT INFORMATION

- Gate** Campground Registration, Bagged & Block Ice, Firewood Sales, Quarter Change Machine, and Doggie "Clean-up" Bags
- Desk** Cabin and Motel Rentals. Mailbox, Postage Stamp Sales, and Brochure Location. (Located inside the grocery store)
- Grocery Store** Groceries, Sundries, Liquor, DVD Rentals, ATM, Ice and Wood Sales
- Gift Shop** Adult & Children Clothing & Accessories, Gifts and Souvenirs
- Boat House** Boat and Pontoon Rentals, Boat Slip Rentals, Fishing Tackle & Supplies, Fishing Licenses, RV & Camping Supplies, Gasoline, Propane and Diesel Sales, Hardware and Snacks.
- Café & Bar** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Served Daily. Daily Specials. Satellite TV & Wi-Fi Connection in the Lounge Area. Friday Night BBQ Dinner (Selected Friday's Only – See BBQ Menu for dates)
- Bear Den** Open Daily during summer months only. Serves Snow Cones, Soft Serve Ice Cream, Popcorn, Chips, Root Beer Floats, Nachos, Sodas, etc. Located across from the gate house. Hours Vary.
- Showers & Laundry** Located throughout the campground. Please refer to the map above for locations

Welcome to Annett's Mono Village

Please read the following information, rules, & regulations

General Information

- Camp registration is complete when you return to the gate house and provide your site number
- ****CHECKOUT &/OR RENEWAL DEADLINE IS 11:00AM****
 - CHECKOUT: Leave your expiring car pass in the box provided at the gate exit
 - RENEW: Bring your expiring car pass to the gate.
 - LATE CHECKOUT: Any vehicle leaving after the 11:00am deadline will be charged a late checkout fee of \$10.00+tax
- **Messages:** Emergency messages will be delivered if we have your site location on file. All other messages are posted at the message board outside of the grocery store. Pay phones are located in front of the café in the event of an emergency Mono County Sheriff Department can be reached at (760) 932-7549
- **WIFI:** Wi Fi Wireless Internet is available in certain areas of the campground. Guest Support Line: 1-866-968-3648

Rules & Regulations

- **Quiet Hours 10:00PM-8:00AM Generator Hours 8:00AM-10:00PM**
- **No Hammocks, No Clotheslines, No Dog Runs, No Ropes, No Nails** put in or on the trees.
- **Firewood:** Bundles may be purchased at the store or gate. You may gather wood that is "dead & down." Do not peel the bark off trees. No chain saw use is allowed at any time. In effort to help stop the spread of invasive pests and diseases, wood transported from other areas is NOT allowed. Limited storage may be available
- **FIREARMS, AIR GUNS, BOWS, SLINGSHOTS, FIREWORKS, TIKI TORCHES CHINESE LANTERNS, FLAME CANDLES, ETC.** are **PROHIBITED** at all times.
- **Bicycle Riders:** Must wear helmets at all times. Bike riding is allowed during daylight hours only
- **Children:** MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES. **Curfew:** 10:00PM for those under 18 years of age.
- **Swimming:** Is allowed ONLY in designated areas. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult at any waterfront. There are NO lifeguards on duty.
- **Electrical Cords/Hoses:** Are not allowed to be run over roadways or between sites
- **Gray & Black Water:** May be disposed of only at the Dump Stations
- **Recreational Vehicles:** 2, 3, or 4 wheeled recreational vehicles and golf carts are prohibited from use on the property
- **Fish Cleaning:** Is only allowed at the fish cleaning station located behind the boathouse
- **Picnic Tables:** ARE NOT TO BE REMOVED from a campsite at any time. Please see the gate if additional tables are requested.
- **Water Hydrants:** Are located throughout the camp. Do not hook up spigot of clean fish at these locations. No dish washing is allowed at faucets or hydrants at any time. Due to drought conditions no watering of roads, washing of cars, etc. is allowed
- **Waterskiing, Jetskis, Etc.:** Allowed between the hours of 10am and 3pm only. Violators will not be allowed back on lake. All Coast Guard & Boating laws must be observed at all times.
- **Payphones:** Are located in front of the café. Cell phone service is not available
- **Wildlife:** Do not feed the, approach, or harass the bears, deer, geese, ducks, etc. Violators will be evicted with no refund

CAMPFIRES

Are allowed ONLY in the provided rock fire pits within designated campsites only. They must be kept at a reasonable size (NO bonfires), and MUST BE ATTENDED AT ALL TIMES. Keep a minimum of 2 gallons of water available at fire pit at all times. Put fire "dead out" before retiring for the night or breaking camp. Campfires are not allowed after midnight, when windy conditions exist, and/or when the NO CAMPFIRE signs are posted throughout the resort. If a fire gets out of control as a result of negligence, you will be held both financially and legally responsible. No outside wood from other areas is allowed into our camp.

Pets

- There is a minimum of two dogs per campsite
- Pets must be kept on a short leash (no more than six feet) **AT ALL TIMES** and remain on a strong durable chain or rope that will not allow the pet to extend off the site in any direction
- Pets must be attended AT ALL TIMES
- All droppings shall be the responsibility of the pet owner and picked up and disposed of properly. Bags are available at the gate and by the marina
- All owners should have the proper vaccination papers available should they be asked for
- If any pet is creating a disturbance or being a nuisance, the pet/s shall be removed with no refund
- Visitors of guests are not permitted to bring pets in the campground
- Children shall not be allowed to walk pets
- Pets found to be creating a nuisance of any kind will be removed by Mono County Animal Control at the owner's expense

BEARS

This is BEAR COUNTRY!! Bears are unpredictable and dangerous, wild animals

- DO NOT: Feed or approach the bears or their cubs
- DOGS ANTAGONIZE BEARS: Keep your pet leashed at ALL times
- Odors Attract Bears: Never leave food in your tent or sleeping area
- Dispose of trash immediately at dumpsters within the campground
- Do not leave food inside of vehicles
- Bears recognize ice chests. If you have one in your car, cover it completely and leave it empty



The above guidelines are only suggestions and do not guarantee that a bear will not enter your camp or disturb your vehicle. We do not accept any responsibility for lost or damaged items. ANYONE seen or reported feeding or harassing the bears will be evicted from the camp immediately with no refund and may be subject to prosecution.
