We are looking for a Part-Time Science Teacher who has a passion for science and who enjoys designing lessons that are engaging, feature deep-learning, and foster creative and critical thinking for small classes that are welcoming, inclusive, and supportive. Tuesday and Thursday classes will be in-person beginning in Fall 2021; Monday classes will be online.

Hourly: \$25-29/hour

Hours: approximately 18 hours per week according to schedule for 34 weeks per year

Job Requirements

- 3 or more years of experience teaching in a classroom setting
- 3 or more years of experience with children
- Passion for teaching science
- Bachelor's degree required; California Teaching Credential preferred
- Enthusiasm for educational options for homeschooled, inquisitive, gifted, and twice exceptional students
- Ability to interact with children with compassion and courtesy
- Exceptional people skills, including strong verbal, written, and interpersonal communication skills
- Experience with Word and Google Docs required; experience with Learning Management Systems, such as Canvas, preferred
- Fingerprinting required

Job Duties

- Design and teach engaging science curriculum for elementary and/or middle school level classes in person on Tuesdays and Thursdays and online classes on Mondays as follows.

Mondays 11:45-2:15

Tuesdays 8:45-2:00

Thursdays 8:45-2:00

In addition there will be 6 hours of prep time.

Science is Fun, grades 2-3 and grades 3-4

Life Science at the Macro Level, grades 3-4 (online)

Environmental Science, grades 5-6 and 6-8

- Communicate with parents weekly via Canvas Learning Management System to keep families apprised of student learning; provide feedback to parents regarding student progress at the end of the session
- Build rapport when communicating with students, families, and colleagues in person, on the phone, and via email; use discretion and confidentiality when processing student and family information
- Set up before and clean up after class as needed, which may include moving tables and chairs
- Walk up and down stairs several times per day; occasionally lift and move materials up to 25 pounds
- Other duties as assigned

Science classes may be combined with teaching additional classes at the elementary, middle, or high school level, in either traditional topics or out-of-the-box class topics.

To perform the Part-Time Teacher job successfully, an individual must be able to perform all essential job duties satisfactorily. These requirements are representative, but not all-inclusive, of the knowledge, skill, and ability required of a Part-Time Teacher.
