Student and Parent Pledge for 2021 Summer Camps

As we return to the field for camps this summer we will still be managing the COVID-19 pandemic to some extent, so it will be vital for everyone in our community (staff, students and parents) to consistently follow a shared set of protocols and expectations for behavior both before (starting 14 days prior to camp) and during your week of camp on Saint Mary's School campus.

Dynasty Goalkeeping is asking you to carefully review the following information and sign below to pledge your commitment to adhering to Dynasty Goalkeeping's COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols and guidelines to create a safe and successful camp experience for all students and staff.

MANDATORY Pre-Camp Health Screening Requirements

All students and staff will submit a pre-camp self-screening questionnaire 24-48 hours prior to camp AND proof of full vaccination or a negative PCR test taken within 1-3 days prior to their specific week of camp via email to both Tracy Noonan and 2021 Dynasty Goalkeeping Certified Athletic Trainer Rebecca Hersch.

DAILY Camp Health Screening

Every student and staff MUST report to our athletic trainer for a DAILY screening and temperature check EVERY morning prior to leaving the dormitory for training.

Reporting Symptoms & Exposure

All families and students are **required** to report any of the following COVID-19 symptoms to Dynasty Goalkeeping Athletic Trainer one week prior and during camp.

- Fever of 100.0° degrees or higher
- Chills
- Shortness of breath
- New cough
- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Unexplained rash
- Sore throat
- Unexplained fatigue
- Unexplained body aches
- Sinus/nasal congestion

All families and students are **required** to report any COVID-19 exposures to Tracy Noonan at Dynasty Goalkeeping 919-225-8154 (cell) & 919-942-2903 (secondary). Exposure is defined as:

- Within the past 14 days, for 15 minutes or more, you have been within six feet of:

- someone presumed to have COVID-19;
- someone diagnosed with COVID-19; and/or someone within two days of that person receiving a positive COVID-19 diagnosis.

Pre-Camp Expectations for Students & Staff

- Students & staff will not attend any mass gatherings that do not adhere to Wake County and North Carolina health and safety orders. [NC DHHS COVID-19](#)
- Students & staff will practice social distancing whenever possible and adhere to mask guidelines.

Travel to Camp

- If it is at all possible driving to and from camp is the preferred method to reduce the chance of exposure while traveling.
- Students who fly into camp will not be excluded, but we ask that EVERY precaution be made to avoid close contact with other travelers and an N95 face mask be worn.
- For unvaccinated students flying into camp if it is feasible to arrive to North Carolina early enough to get your PCR test done in NC after arriving here, but before camp, that would be our preference to minimize risk for all students.

Shuttle Service

- Airport shuttle service will ONLY be provided to students that provide proof of FULL vaccination.
- Only fully vaccinated staff coaches will transport one student per vehicle.
- Masks will be worn while in vehicle and student will ride in the back seat to maintain distance.

During Camp Expectations for Students & Staff

- Students & staff will wear a mask or cloth face covering per Dynasty Goalkeeping's COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols.
- Students & staff will wear a mask in dormitories, gymnasium, and weight room, or a safe social distance can be maintained.
- Students & staff will be sure to maintain proper social distance of 6+ feet when masks are off for eating and drinking.
- Students & staff will wear a mask while outdoors in close proximity and during training UNLESS this North Carolina state guideline is updated prior to camp.
- Students & staff will practice social distancing at all times and be diligent with hand washing, especially prior to meals.

Off-Campus Expectations for All Students & Staff (including urgent care treatment & camp field trip)

- Students CANNOT leave campus for training, game or any other personal commitments.
- Students & staff will wear a mask or cloth face covering per Wake County and State of North Carolina orders if they must leave campus to seek injury treatment.
- Students & staff will wear a mask or cloth face covering per Wake County and State of North Carolina orders during optional nutrition outing (a 0.6 mile walk to Weaver Street Market, a local grocery store).

Housing for All Students & Staff

- All students & staff will be required to stay on campus.
- Students will be housed one per room with the exception of SOLD OUT weeks. Due to housing limitations during sold out weeks we will have to make 2 rooms double occupancy (impacting 4 students). Only local (drive-in) students who have been fully vaccinated will be considered for double occupancy housing.

Expectations for All Parents

- All parents visiting campus will complete Dynasty Goalkeeping's screening form and adhere to Dynasty Goalkeeping's COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols while on campus, including wearing a mask/face covering, maintaining social distance, and washing hands frequently.
- Parents will drop off and pick-up student OUTSIDE the dormitory to minimize overall numbers and reduce risk inside the dormitory. No family members will be allowed inside unless it is an emergency. This means students will have to transport all their belongings and unpack/pack their own rooms. In special circumstances entry will be permitted with proof of full vaccination or negative PCR Covid test within 1-3 days prior to camp.
- Parents are permitted to watch sessions from afar in the stands overlooking the field but MUST maintain significant distance from the group and your child unless it is an emergency. No outside points of contact are permitted during the week to preserve our "mini-bubble" as best we can.

Medical Evacuation Protocol

If a student or staff coach exhibits symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or other communicable illness, tests positive for COVID-19, requires COVID-19 testing, or if our certified athletic trainer decides their condition is such that they must depart campus, evacuation must occur as soon as possible, preferably **within 2 hours** of being contacted by Dynasty Goalkeeping. This may mean housing your daughter at a local hotel until you are available to pick her up or until she is cleared for travel. Remember, rideshares, buses, and air travel may not be available or may not allow your daughter to be a passenger if she is ill or symptomatic. Arranging all aspects of transportation and lodging will be the responsibility of the parents. **Student will NOT be allowed to self-isolate or quarantine at Saint Mary's School.** The closest and best option is located only ½ mile from Saint Mary's School:

Response and Management of Case(s) or Probable Case(s)

If a student or staff coach is identified as having a potential or confirmed case of COVID-19, the individual will be isolated in her room as part of the camp's communicable disease plan (CDP) until evacuation can be arranged as discussed above. Protocols outlined in the CDP and the following will be considered:

- If a student or staff coach warrants further clinical evaluation, arrangements will be made to do so preferably by the parents (if local), otherwise by staff.
- If student or staff coach does not require immediate clinical evaluation, and if CDP calls for the individual to return home, isolate the individual until appropriate return to home transportation can be arranged.

- Clean the person’s areas of contact according to CDP and procedures outlined in ACA Field Guide.
- Contact tracing will be carried out by trained staff in conjunction with public health staff, community health workers, trained volunteers, and the local health department.
- Continuation of camp for remaining staff and students will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Student Cancellation due to COVID19 Illness

Should a student be unable to attend camp due to a positive COVID19 test result, camp credit minus the \$500 non-refundable deposit will be given upon receipt of official medical documentation. If the student can produce 2 consecutive negative PCR results she can be considered for future 2021 weeks if space permits, if not the non-transferable credit is valid through summer 2022.

Camp Cancellation due to COVID19

Should a Dynasty Goalkeeping camp have to be cancelled **PRIOR** to the start of camp due to low enrollment or COVID19 related issues the following options will be considered in the following order:

1. Transfer student into another available week.
2. Full credit (non-transferable) through summer 2022. If Zoom lectures are provided then the \$500 deposit would be subtracted.
3. Tuition refund minus the non-refundable \$500 deposit.

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious disease including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce the risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for any injury, illness, disability or death related to my participation, whether physical, social or economic including, but not limited to, the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19); and,

Due to the ongoing pandemic, we must anticipate that even with our pre-camp requirements and in camp policies that there may be times when individual student(s) and/or staff may be required to leave campus. As such we are requiring each family to share their student's departure plan from campus should she become ill or need to quarantine for a period of time.

The components of this plan must include:
