Flutur is a 67-year-old woman in Albasan, Albania. She is married and lives with her elderly husband, who in a month turns 80 years old. Flutur must prepare to take care of him as he is in dire need of an eye surgery to regain his eyesight.

Together they wish to take out a loan of \$1,100 USD in order to have the surgery and regain his eyesight.

GIVING A HELPING HAND

This loan is designed for low-income families in Albania who have medical expenses that they cannot afford to pay. Low-income families are often forced to sell family assets or resort to informal lenders in order to pay for unexpected medical bills. This loan is designed to give families a helping hand by providing a grace period of up to six months. This will allow individuals to get treatment, recover and resume work before having to make repayments.
