To ensure that communications and outreach to all Ministry Membership provides mechanisms which allow information sharing with diverse communication, ability, and resources.

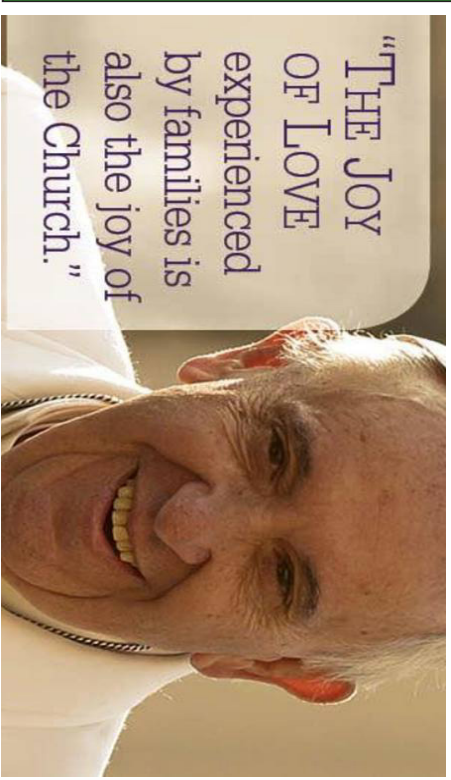
Ensure event and program planning activities are as inclusive as possible to the SJECC Family of Parishioners and the
