

COVID-19 POLICY

To maintain healthy operations and prevent the spread of COVID-19, the club has instituted the following policies:

Admission to the club:

- Members must check in upon arrival at the **designated entrance area only**.
- Anyone that has tested positive, or been in contact with an individual that has tested positive for COVID-19, shall not be admitted to the club for 14 days. Anyone feeling ill for any reason should not come to the club. To this effect, adult members must complete a waiver (one time) and a declaration of health form (every time) on entry.
- Masks must be worn by members and staff when checking in.
- Staff will measure the temperature with a non-contact thermometer of all persons arriving to the club. Entry will be denied if temperature is 100.4°F or higher.
- Guest passes will be accepted once PA is in the green phase, as long as the facility has not reached capacity. (Maximum number of guests per family may be restricted).

Maintaining a healthy facility:

- **Hand Hygiene** - Hand sanitizer will be available for use in the lobby and snack bar. Proper hand-washing instructions will be posted in the restrooms.
- **Masks** - Staff and Members will wear a cloth or medical face mask that covers the nose and mouth while in the snack bar, lobby, restrooms, while checking in, and in the office. No face mask shall be worn in the swimming pools

- **Cleaning** - Restrooms (sinks, toilet handles, counter tops) will be wiped down hourly. Handrails, guard stands, and dividing boards rails wiped down hourly
- **Preventing contamination** –
 - There will be no use of the water fountain.
 - Pool toys are not permitted.
 - Members must bring their own floatation devices (for infants/toddlers 4 yr. and under only)
 - No chairs provided on the deck (except the guard chair).
 - Members are responsible for bringing and taking their chairs and infant/toddler flotation devices home with them. We are unable to store items as contamination could occur.
- **Playground** - Members are responsible for supervising their children and maintaining social distancing while using the playground equipment
- **Snack Bar** –
 - Use the marked entrance and exit for the snack bar to ensure one-way flow of people.
 - There will be one ordering window and one food pick up window.
 - Marks on the floor will indicate proper distancing while waiting.
 - No indoor seating.
- **Camp** – Camp participants will be rotating through the property in supervised small groups.
- **One-way entrance and exit** – Follow signs to enter and exit from designated areas only.

Members and staff are expected to comply with all rules and policies provided in this document and posted throughout the club. Parents are responsible for educating their children regarding social distancing. The management reserves the right to refuse admission to, or eject, persons who do not comply with these measures.

Policies may change as statewide guidelines are relaxed or imposed.
