

# **Egypt on the Potomac FT 2020 - FAQs**

## **Are there ID or minimum age requirements to enter the event?**

ID is required to verify child, student, and senior ticket purchases.

Child tickets: children must be 7-17 years old. Children under 7 can participate for free if they sit on their guardian's lap. Any child under 7 who needs their own seat, must have their own ticket.

Student tickets: require a valid student ID.

Senior tickets: must be 65 years or older.

## **What are my transportation/parking options for getting to and from the event?**

We recommend taking the Metro. The Thurgood Marshall Center Trust is conveniently located 3 blocks from the U Street/ African American Civil War Memorial/ Cardozo Metro Station on the green and yellow lines. Limited street parking is available near the Thurgood Marshall Center Trust. Pay careful attention to the signs. Additionally, you can park in the building lot if spaces are available.

## **Where does the Field Trip take place?**

The Field Trip begins and ends at the Thurgood Marshall Center Trust, 1816 12th Street, NW. During the Field Trip, you will visit sites throughout Washington, D.C. including Meridian Hill Park, the Scottish Rite Temple, the House of the Temple, L'Enfant Plaza and Banneker Circle.

## **What should I bring with me on the Field Trip?**

Be sure to wear comfortable walking shoes. We recommend bringing water, sunglasses, and something to take notes with. Video or audio recording of the Field Trip is NOT permitted.

## **Is lunch included? Can we stop for lunch during the Field Trip?**

Lunch is not included in the Field Trip. If your group would like to eat together, you can plan to do so after the Field Trip. There are several restaurants nearby on U Street.

## **Are there bathroom breaks?**

The bus does not stop for bathroom breaks during the Field Trip. Some of the buses have bathrooms. We encourage participants to use the bathroom before the bus departs the Thurgood Marshall Center Trust.

### **Is the Field Trip wheel chair accessible?**

Buses are only equipped to store wheel chairs. Some stops on the field trip do involve stairs. If someone can get on and off the bus, accommodations can be made at the site visits.

### **Do I have to bring my printed ticket to the event?**

No. If you do not print your ticket, you may be asked to show your ticket confirmation on your mobile device.

### **What happens if I get stuck in traffic and am running late?**

The Field Trip begins and ends at the IKG Cultural Resource Center located in the Thurgood Marshall Center Trust building. If you do not arrive at least 10 minutes before the start of the Field Trip, seating is not guaranteed. If you arrive late and your seat is still available, you will be responsible for your own transportation to meet up with the group. See below if you arrive late and your seat has been sold.

### **What happens if I am no longer able to attend the Field Trip for the scheduled date and time of my ticket?**

We understand that life happens. You can make a one-time transfer of your Field Trip ticket to a future date during the current Field Trip season by emailing [egyptonthepotomac@gmail.com](mailto:egyptonthepotomac@gmail.com) at least 48 hours before the Field Trip. If you need to change your Field Trip ticket with less than 48 hours notice, there is a \$5 service fee to change the time and date of your ticket.
