4. Why awareness of ACEs is helping communities foster resilience and the results from applying trauma-informed practices.
5. Current initiatives in NYS and Erie & Monroe counties involving trauma-informed practices and ACEs awareness.
6. Ways various sectors of our communities can work together using the seven strategies of building resilience.
