

**ORDINANCE NO. 20210308-2**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF DISASTER ISSUED BY MAYORAL PROCLAMATION ON FEBRUARY 19, 2021 IN RESPONSE TO THE SEVERE WINTER STORM.**

**WHEREAS**, on February 19, 2021, Jerrod Jones, Mayor of the City of Buffalo, Texas (the "City"), issued a Mayoral Proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City to facilitate and expedite the use and deployment of resources to enhance preparedness and response to a severe winter storm that affected the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions necessitating such disaster declaration continue to exist; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect life and property threatened by this severe winter storm; and


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 418.108(b), Texas Government Code, a local state disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governmental body of the political subdivision;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The declaration disaster, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on February 19, 2021, and continued to be effective through February 26, 2021, shall hereby be renewed and extended for an additional sixty (60) days through April 28, 2021, as authorized by Section 418.018 of the Texas Government Code.
