

## Minutes February 25, 2020

The City of Langdon place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church.

Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Mike Frank, Commissioners Kenny Bauer, Charlie O'Bryan, Scott Scinta, Attorney Stan Chauvin III and City Clerk/Treasurer Theresa O'Bryan.

Absent from the meeting: Commissioners Aaron Hardy

Guests attending the meeting: Sam Wellhausen

The minutes from the January meeting were read. Council member Charlie O'Bryan made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council member Kenny Bauer seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 4/0.

Mayor Frank began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Frank informed the council that the 48th District Representative Maria Sorolis requested the Council to invite the resident to attend a regular monthly meeting, in which she would like to poll the residents on their concerns for the district.

A resident informed the council of a parking issue on Wareham. Due to the narrow court, a resident or guest of 2812 Wareham parks on the street blocking the driveway of 2814 Wareham Drive. It was suggested to have David Mudd the ordinance office to talk to the neighbor who resides at 2812 Wareham Road to resolve the issue.

Tree trimming was completed today by Bob Ray and Company.

LG&E priced replacing current lighting with the LED street lights. The proposal cost was \$477.64 higher per month for the next 60 months. After the 60 months the cost would be \$35.44 higher each month. The council decided not to pursue this project at this time due to the higher cost.

Mail a copy of David Tapp's invoice for mailbox repair of 9014 Duxbury to resident.

Council member Bauer asked the LMPD police to patrol the four way stops. Bauer also has MSD coming to repair the damaged asphalt cover at 2606 Wareham Road.

Council member Scott Scinta will be publishing a newsletter in the next few weeks. Scinta also informed the City that Lawnco put down pre-emergent liquid fertilizer on the entrance ways and greenspaces. He also asked them to take care of the two Memorials on Kennersley Drive.

Attorney Chauvin reported on the annexation issue ordinance #48.89. He feels the best way to move forward would be to have a conference call between the Secretary of State and Logic

Finance Report: The monthly bill report was presented to the council for review. Council member Scinta made a motion to approve the bills and council member O'Bryan seconded it. It passed 4/0 in favor.

The next meeting will be March 24, 2020 at 7:00pm.
