

Minutes June 23, 2020

The City of Langdon place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church.

Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Mike Frank, Commissioners Kenny Bauer, Charlie O'Bryan, Aaron Hardy, Attorney Stan Chauvin III and City Clerk/Treasurer Theresa O'Bryan.

Absent from the meeting: Scott Scinta

Guests attending the meeting: None

The minutes from the May meeting were read. Council member Charlie O'Bryan made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council member Aaron Hardy seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 4/0.

Mayor Mike Frank began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Frank informed the Council that Bob Ray will be treating 139 trees for Emerald ash borer in the next several months.

The Kentucky Department for Local Government has allocated up to \$70,162 for a Coronavirus relief fund, available to City of Langdon Place. Mayor Mike will look into ways the fund can be accessed.

Mayor Frank reported to the Council that there were several trees in the easement at 2614 Titleist Road that needed dead branches trimmed. He will be looking into having the trees trimmed or replaced.

Due to the Covid 19 virus the Council unanimously decided to postpone the citywide yard sales until a further date.

Commissioner Aaron Hardy presented the Council with the dates of the leaf pick up in the fall. The dates are as follows:

Week of November 9th-13th

Week of December 7th-11th

Council member Aaron Hardy will look into having the landscape around the Goose Creek entrance walls trimmed or removed before the refurbishing takes place.

Commissioner Charlie O'Bryan will be walking sidewalks tomorrow with Joey from Louisville Paving and checking on the city curbs in need of repair. He will report back next month on this project. Council member Kenny Bauer asked Commissioner Charlie O'Bryan to look at the sidewalk at 2812 Kennersley Drive to make sure that sidewalk was in the scope for repairs.

Council member Bauer reported that MSD has been working on the ditch lines behind Blossom. MSD will be working on this project for the next 5 weeks. The project includes grading an L-Shape drainage area and pouring a concrete basin

Attorney Chauvin informed the Council that he sent information on the annexation issue at hand to Candi Atkinson. He will talk to her next week to see what is needed to resolve this matter.

Finance Report: The second reading of Ordinance # 1 Series 2020 Ad Valorem tax assessment and Ordinance #2 Series 2020 Annual budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. Council member Kenny Bauer made a motion to accept Ordinance # 1 Series 2020 Ad Valorem tax assessment and Ordinance #2 Series 2020 Annual budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 as read. Council member Charlie O'Bryan seconded it. It passed 4/0 in acceptance.

The monthly bill report was presented to the council for review. Council member Charlie O'Bryan made a motion to approve the bills and council member Kenny Bauer seconded it. It passed 4/0 in favor.

The next meeting will be July 28, 2020 at 7:00pm.
