

Minutes March 23, 2021

The City of Langdon place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church.

Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Mike Frank, Commissioners Kenny Bauer, Charlie O'Bryan, Scott Scinta, and City Clerk/Treasurer Theresa O'Bryan.

Absent from the meeting: Aaron Hardy and Attorney Stan Chauvin III

Mayor Mike Frank began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the February meeting were read. Council member Scott Scinta made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council member Charlie O'Bryan seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 4 /0.

David Mudd briefed the council on the pretrial conference scheduled June 17 for the resident in parking violation. There are 30 different occasions of violations resulting in fines at \$250 per violation.

Mayor Frank will be obtaining quotes for mulching the city trees for the April meeting.

Mayor Frank also was able to reach an agreement with Brownsboro Lawn care for the second leaf removal at a reduced price of \$1875.00. The original price charged was \$3250.00.

An Ecotech Sanitation company truck struck a tree branch on Acushnet Court and broke the branch off the tree. The truck is going back to pick up the fallen branch.

A stop sign at Blossom and Wareham was shot with a pellet gun. Mayor Mike talked with Duggins, who will be replacing the sign in the next several weeks.

Council member Scott Scinta was able to get the website updated with the Reach Alert sign up instructions. Scott also suggested that the Council look into spending additional funds in the upcoming budget year to do an overhaul of the website to refresh the information pages,

Council member Kenny Bauer is going to check with MSD and see how many open work orders they have for our City. He reported that he was not satisfied with the recent MSD cleaning of ditch lines

Finance Report: The monthly bill report was presented to the Council for review. Council member Scott Scinta made a motion to approve the bills and council member Charlie O'Bryan seconded it. It passed in favor 4/0.

The next meeting will be April 27, 2021 at 7:00pm.
