RE: Air Cadet League of Canada (OPC) 2019 Lottery Tickets

Dear Cadets, Parents and Guardians:

Every squadron in Ontario participates in the selling of lottery tickets. Proceeds from the sale of these lottery tickets will go directly to maintaining gliders and tow planes for the Gliding Programme which all cadets have the opportunity to enjoy.

Each squadron is financially responsible for all books of lottery tickets issued by the Air Cadet League Ontario Provincial Committee. To this end, 820 Chris Hadfield Squadron, as well as many other squadrons, have implemented a process of the sale of these lottery tickets that allows fairness to all cadets, parents/guardians, simplifies the administration process of the Squadron Sponsoring Committee (SSC) and ensures minimal financial risk to the squadron.

In addition to the Annual Registration Fee (see attached letter) of \$160.00 per cadet, **each cadet is required to sell a minimum of 1 book of lottery tickets for which a deposit of \$60 is required.** The deposit for the lottery tickets will be returned to the cadet once the cadet has sold all of the lottery tickets. Once sold, the lottery ticket stubs are to be promptly returned to the Squadron. Each cadet remains responsible for the lottery tickets and the return of the ticket stubs. Should the cadet wish to sell more lottery tickets to further assist the Squadron, they may do so only upon the complete sale of their first book of lottery tickets. Loss of, or failure to return, the sold tickets will result in the forfeit of the \$60 deposit.
