Materials available for curbside pickup are materials that were ordered in from across the province and delivered to the library. You will be notified that your requests are available for pick up, and you will need to phone the library or contact me however to arrange a pick-up appointment time, then coming at the scheduled time to pick up your request that will be ready at the outside table for pick-up.**

****The library will remain locked to the public until further notice. We are not sure of a date of when we will be open to the public yet.**

****We will not be accepting cash or fine payments while we are doing curbside. Patrons who owe more than \$10 will not be blocked from borrowing.**
