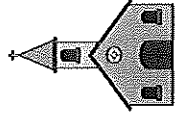

\*\*\*\*\*Town Council would like to remind vehicle owners that the Town of Colonsay has a Traffic Bylaw that prohibits parking of vehicles on the streets and boulevards for more than 72 hours. The Bylaw also prohibits unhitched trailers from being parked on the street. In addition, there are areas within the Town where there is no parking permitted at any time as indicated by signage. Town Council intends to enforce the Traffic Bylaw by towing and impounding of vehicles in contravention of the Traffic Bylaw via services provided by Brad's Towing, Saskatoon.
