

Explanation of the Judi Famous Music Fund, for Harford County teachers:

Judi Famous was an amazing music educator and professional oboist who worked in the Harford County Public School System for 30 years. Following her passing, after a battle with pancreatic cancer in 2005, a committee of members from Emory United Methodist Church in Street, MD was formed to carry out one of her final wishes – the establishment of a fund to be made available to music students from Harford County in need of financial assistance, for music lessons, or summer camp or an instrument purchase. To date we have given over \$33,000.00 to deserving students. Most stipends are in the amount of \$500.00.

Please consider a special student you teach that could benefit from private lessons, or a summer music camp, or a better instrument, but you know that money is an issue, and encourage them to apply for this opportunity. While musical talent is important, financial need is a large factor in determining who receives some money.

Please note. We are interested in helping students who are currently in grades 6 – 11. This is not meant to be a college scholarship

We have been providing stipends to deserving students since 2008, in the name of our good friend, Judi Famous, who was a Harford County music teacher, musician and mentor.

Qualifications for the Judith Lloyd Famous Music Stipend are:

1. Applicant must be a Harford County resident
2. Applicant must be currently enrolled in grades 6 – 11 with a demonstrated interest in music.
 - a. The applicant must be prepared to play/sing an audition for the Music Fund committee.
3. Applicant's family must provide a statement/letter explaining the need for, and purpose of the money.
4. As succinctly as possible, the applicant should explain his/her interest in music and how this scholarship would be used.
5. Applicant must provide a letter of recommendation from their school music teacher and/or private music teacher.

Applications and letters will be accepted until Friday April 3, 2020. The audition date is scheduled for the afternoon of Sunday, April 19, 2020. Students will be notified by email if they are invited to play an audition. The committee reserves the right to limit the number of applicants who will audition, and all decisions of the committee are final.
