

Call for Peer Reviewers

Review for Religious is seeking peer reviewers with a wide variety of backgrounds and interests to assist in reviewing articles for the journal. The journal will maintain a database with the names and interests of reviewers and will match them to articles as needed. This journal will have both an academic and pastoral approach, so a diversity of background in reviewers is appreciated.

The journal follows a double-blind review process, so author and reviewer remain anonymous to each other throughout the process. Reviewers are asked to evaluate the article and make publishing recommendations which will then go to the editorial board for final decision. Reviewers for a specific article will be used in the order that they accept.

The editorial board will make decisions about peer reviewers based on their qualifications and the need to have widely distributed areas of expertise that cover the variety of article subjects the journal wishes to publish.
