Please allow me to begin by thanking all of you for your patience support and kind words over the past two weeks. As we conclude our second week of remote learning, we are still learning about the methods that work well and the things that need to be altered.

We will continue with our remote learning program for the duration of the closure. We will also make a final decision about spring break within the next few days.
