Fawcett in memory of their parents. The title of this property was transferred to The Couchiching Conservancy in 2013.

The Thomas C. Agnew Nature Reserve was partially purchased/partially donated in 2011 to The Couchiching Conservancy by sisters Susan Campbell and Joan Berndt in memory of their grandfather, Thomas C. Agnew. The Township of Severn was supportive of this acquisition and contributed financially.

It is locally known that Robert Fawcett and Thomas Agnew were friends in their day, and that these adjoining nature reserves are fine testament to the character and legacy of these gentlemen.
