

PHASE 1: Operations under current Covid-19 recommendations

Release of Liability:

Participant acknowledges and agrees that despite Rogue Valley ZipLine Adventure's best efforts, it cannot eliminate all potential risks and there remains a risk that Participant could be inadvertently exposed to the COVID-19 virus during the activities. Participant voluntarily desires to participate in the activities with knowledge of the risks involved and by signing below agrees to assume and accept any and all risk of potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus in connection with those activities, including but not limited to illness and death, or other injury or loss relating to COVID-19. In consideration for permitting Participant to voluntarily participate in the activities, Participant, or Participant's legal guardian as the case may be, hereby agrees to release and hold harmless Rogue Valley ZipLine Adventures, along with its members, employees, and agents (collectively referred to as "the Released Parties") from any and all liability and/or claims whatsoever arising out of or related to any illness, up to and including death, loss, or damage that Participant may suffer as a result of any exposure to the COVID-19 virus during the activities. This release includes but is not limited to any such illness, loss, or damage that may arise as a result of the negligence of the Released Parties but excluding any claim based upon the intentional misconduct of the Released Parties.

Rogue Valley ZipLine Adventures precautions:

Regularly touched surfaces and equipment will be regularly wiped or sprayed with disinfectant. Tour operations and reservations have been adjusted to maintain healthier tour environments. A handwashing station is available and hand sanitizer is provided. We will minimize human contact by helping oversee a 6 foot separation of family units. Our guides will wear masks during the tour when they cannot keep a 6 foot separation.

1. Staff/guests **will not** be allowed to work/participate if any **signs or symptoms of flu** appear.
 - **Coughing and sneezing, Fever, Difficulty breathing, Diarrhea or stomach problems**
2. If an infrared thermometer is available employees/guests **temperature will be checked** before start of tour.
3. Groups will be **required to wear a mask during the shuttle ride** into the park. Masks can be removed for the duration of the tour and are only required during the shuttle portion.
4. Groups/families will stay **6 feet apart** from other groups/families throughout the entirety of the tour.
5. We are **unable to provide ADA Friendly tours at this time** due to the close physical contact restrictions. We are also not able to use our 4x4 vehicle to eliminate hiking for any guests.
6. **Contact us immediately if anyone in your party develops any signs of COVID-19 within 14 days after your tour.**
In the event that anyone from your tour contacts us about developing symptoms or a diagnosis of Covid-19, reservation information will be used to contact all participants.

Recommended:

1. If you have a weakened immune system or an underlying condition that can be affected by possible exposure to covid-19 then please avoid participating.
2. It is recommended that your group carry your own small container of hand sanitizer in order to maintain cleanliness throughout the tour although hand sanitizer is available on site. Continuously use sanitizer if you have touched your face, mouth, eyes or other possibly contaminated surface.
3. The Governor of Oregon recommends people stay close to home. We are supposed to encourage the public to visit parks and recreation areas close to home, avoid overnight trips and minimize travel outside your immediate area for recreation. ****Caution**** Please do not travel outside of your home area if you live in an area with a high number of reported COVID-19 cases. Please help stop the spread!
