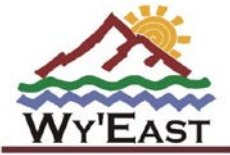

Small Businesses, Farmers and Ranchers. Projects to be located in rural areas. Can finance/loan up to 75% of total project cost. Grant can never finance more than 25% of a project or \$500,000 - whichever is less.
